Organizer Report





Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I hope all of you were able to spend some quality time with family and friends over the holidays. 2024 has been a very busy year in the local for work and 2025 will be the same. The long arrival for the Ho-Chunk Casino in Beloit is here and expected to start ramping up in early spring. Cupertino in Edgerton will have steady work throughout 2025 as well.

2024 was a great year for organizing efforts. I attended over 10 high school career days throughout our jurisdiction and had great interactions with students at each event. I attended 5 organizing blitzes throughout the state during the year. My fellow organizers and myself visited over 3500 doors in 2024. 950 doors were visited in the Local 890 jurisdiction. We have organized a new contractor into the local, Accelerated Electric. Accelerated Electric focuses on the residential and light commercial markets. We are at an all-time high for membership in 890. We have accomplished our goal of hitting 800 members by the end of 2024. Our total membership stands at 841 members.

Organizing efforts will not slow down in 2025. I will be attending 6 organizing blitzes throughout Wisconsin. with more possibly to come. I will be attending 5 high school career fairs throughout our jurisdiction, with more to come. Local 890 will be hosting two job fairs in April of 2025. To cover more of our jurisdiction, one event will be held in Janesville, with the other being held in Lake Geneva. We will also be hosting COMET classes throughout the year at the hall. COMET is a course that explains the importance of organizing, and why we all need to be involved in organizing efforts. The International requires each local to have 80% of its membership to be trained in COMET. If anyone has questions about this course feel free to call me at the hall. My goal is to visit more non-union jobsites this coming year to attempt organizing. It is important to visit our own members as well on jobsites, so I will be increasing union job sites visits as well.

I want to give a sincere thank you to all the members who have helped me in the past year with the events we hosted. Your help does not go unrecognized and is greatly appreciated. I look forward to serving all of you as lead organizer in 2025 and thank everyone for your ongoing support.
