# **IBEW Local 890's Newsletter**

### **BUSINESS MANAGER'S REPORT**

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

We're excited to share some great news from our recent contract negotiations with the contractors. After a lot of hard work and collaboration, we've reached a settlement that includes the following wage increases over the next three years:

- Year 1: 5.6% (\$3.75 increase)
- Year 2: 5% (\$3.50 increase)
- Year 3: 4% (\$3.00 increase)

These increases represent more than a **\$20,000 boost to our total package** over the term of the contract. One of the main goals of our negotiating team, along with the contractors, is to work toward closing the wage gap with our neighboring locals. We are making significant strides to ensure that our members are compensated fairly for the hard work they do.

#### Wage Allocation Vote

We'll be holding a wage allocation vote on **May 1st at our union meeting** at **6:00 PM**. Please make sure to attend and cast your vote as we move forward with this new contract. Your participation is important!

# IBEW Local 890 2025 Summary of Benefits Negotiated

- ANNUAL CONTRACT RAISES (Distributed between: Check, Retirements and Healthcare)
  - June 1, 2024 + \$2.38 = \$66.82/hour total package\* (+3.7%)
    - \$43.65/hour on the check- Previous Contract '22-'25
  - June 1, 2025 + \$3.75 = \$70.57/hour total package\* (+5.61%)
    - TBD May meeting/hour on the check
  - $\circ$  June 1, 2026 + \$3.50 = \$74.01/hour total package\* (+4.96%)
    - On check TBD
  - $\circ$  June 1, 2027 + \$3.00 = \$77.07/hour total package\* (+4.05%)
    - On check TBD
  - June 2028 Open Contract to be negotiated

### RETIREMENT

- 401A 25% Employer Contribution
- o 401K Optional Pre-tax Employee-only contribution 2,3,5,10 or 15%
- NEBF Defined Benefit Pension \$33 per month X years of service
- PBF Defined Benefit Pension \$5.50 per month X years of membership

  - Medical Family PPO coverage
  - Dental Two free exam/cleanings plus \$1700 towards other dental care per year per participant
